

## Watershed Council to meet Oct. 21

The Henry's Fork Watershed Council will meet Oct. 21 at the Springhill Marriott in Rexburg, beginning at 8 a.m. with registration. Speakers include Mike Beus of the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation, Rob Van Kirk of the Henry's Fork Foundation, Amy Verbeten of Friends of the Teton River, Brian Reed of the Idaho Soil and Water Conservation Commission and Mike Rasmussen of the North Fork Canal Company. Topics include drought management, winter water flows, water storage, watershed research and monitoring, TMDL implementation and Henry's Lake Outlet report. The meeting will wrap up before noon.
