You and a guest will join Chocolate Lab Expeditions for a 9-day tour fishing 3 different rivers from March 29-April 6 in Patagonia. Over 80 miles of combined exclusive private access offered within the three fishing ranches. Early fall fishing (March-May in Patagonia) should offer mayfly hatches on all three rivers and caddis as well on the Limay Tailwater—a timeframe targeted by dry fly enthusiasts and steamer junkies alike. While big browns are available throughout the season on the Limay, this timeframe should offer shots at big browns on the other rivers as well as they start to stage for spawning. Water temps should still be warm enough to target the large browns on the Limay with dry flies. Prime dates and rivers, with fantastic food and first class accommodations and Malbees!

Based in San Martin de los Andes, Chocolate Lab Expeditions (CLE), offers some of the best fishing in all of Patagonia and more private access water than anyone else in the area. Owners Ron and Vanessa Sorensen have been guiding and outfitting anglers in Northern Patagonia since 1996, building a reputation for dependable excellence as they have shared their passion for fishing Patagonia over the years.

March 29

- Arrive into Chapelco Airport, San Martin de Los Andes
- CLE guide awaiting to transfer you 20 min the Chimehuin RiverHouse
- Float Chimehuin for the afternoon with riverside picnic
- Take out and return to the lodge Open bar, dinner, and night at the lodge

March 30

- Breakfast at the lodge
- Float Chimehuin River for the day with riverside picnic
- Take out and return to the lodge
- Appetizers, open bar, dinner, and night at River House

March 31

- Breakfast at the lodge
- Leave packed bags in the hallway before heading out to fish
- Float the lower Chimehuin for the day with riverside picnic
- Arrive to the confluence with the Collon Cura River
- Take out on a private lease, and transfer 1.5 hrs to Limay River Ranch
- Appetizers and open bar before dinner, dinner, and night at the lodge

April 1-3

- Breakfast at the lodge
- Float/wade the Limay tailwater with riverside picnics

- Return to the lodge in the evening, appetizers, open bar and dinner

April 4

- Breakfast at LRR
- -bPack and transfer 2.5 hours to Estancia San Huberto for the 12 noon check in
- Fish Malleo for the day with riverside picnic
- Return to the lodge after fishing, open bar, dinner, and night at the lodge

April 5-6

- Breakfast at the lodge
- Fish the Malleo for the day with riverside picnic
- -Return to the lodge in the evenings, open bar, dinner, and night at the lodge

April 7

- Breakfast at the lodge
- Transfer takes the group to Chapelco Airport


