### Job Description:

- Conduct field work including field work in lakes, reservoirs, and rivers to monitor water quality
- Assist with data collection, analysis, and reporting
- Support long-term management initiatives aimed at improving water quality
- Manage volunteers
- Drive a boat
- Wade and/or snorkel
- Interview recreational water users



### Qualifications

- Valid driver's license
- Good written and oral communication skills
- Field work experience
- Data collection experience
- Ability to work independently on some tasks and as a member of a team on others.
- Ability to work outside and carry ~25lbs
- Ability to work outdoors around water, even in inclement weather
- Ability to think independently and critically.
- Personal vehicle (will have access to HFF vehicles for work purposes only).
- Ability to work ~40 hours a week

## **Vehicles**

- HFF vehicles are for field work only. The intern should have a personal vehicle that will help them get to and from the grocery store and other locations.

## **Work Schedule**

- 40 hours a week
- Must attend weekly Monday staff meetings.

## **Additional Work Expectations**

- May be asked to occasionally assist with various other HFF projects including restoration projects, water quality monitoring, and education and outreach events.

## **Mentor**

- The mentor for this Internship position is Joe Hively, HFF's Field and Lab Coordinator.
- The intern will also work closely with HFF's intern coordinator, Jasper Davis.

## **What to Expect**

- Ashton, Idaho is rural with a population of ~1,000 people.
- There is 1 small, local grocery store and limited dining options in Ashton, so many drive to surrounding cities such as Rexburg to shop/dine.
- Ashton is close to Island Park that hosts hiking, fishing, and recreational outdoor activities. There are bike trails in Ashton, and Ashton is also within an hour of West Yellowstone.
