Living Arrangements

- Housing provided - two bunk rooms that are separated by gender, two large bathroom/shower facilities, kitchen, laundry facilities, and a living room.

Vehicles

- HFF vehicles are for field work only. The intern should have a personal vehicle that will help them get to and from the grocery store and other locations.

Work Schedule

- 40 hours a week
- Must attend weekly Monday staff meetings.

Additional Work Expectations

- May be asked to occasionally assist with various other HFF projects including restoration projects, water quality monitoring, and education and outreach events.

Mentor

- The mentor for this Internship position is Jack McLaren, HFF's Aquatic Ecology Program Manager.
- The intern will also work closely with HFF's intern coordinator, Jasper Davis.

What to Expect

- Ashton, Idaho is rural with a population of ~1,000 people.
- There is 1 small, local grocery store and limited dining options in Ashton, so many drive to surrounding cities such as Rexburg to shop/dine.
- Ashton is close to Island Park that hosts hiking, fishing, and recreational outdoor activities. There are bike trails in Ashton, and Ashton is also within an hour of West Yellowstone.
